



# New Zealand's greenhouse gas emissions by sector and gas 2016

Title	New Zealand's greenhouse gas emissions by sector and gas 2016
Publisher	New Zealand's Environment Reporting Series: The Ministry for the Environment and Statistics New Zealand
Description	We measure gases that are added to the atmosphere through human activities. This does not include natural sources such as biological processes or volcanic emissions. We report greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions in carbon dioxide equivalent (CO <sub>2</sub> -e) units, which is a measure for how much global warming a given type and amount of greenhouse gas causes, using the equivalent amount of carbon dioxide as the reference. CO <sub>2</sub> -e is used for describing different greenhouse gases in a common unit, which allows them to be reported consistently. Data may not include the latest emissions data, which can be found on the Ministry for the Environment's website.
